



JOB VACANCY- MAINTENANCE LABOURER

The Maintenance Labourer is assigned to the Maintenance Unit of the Eco-Industrial Development Company of Tobago (E-IDCOT) Ltd. and is primarily stationed at the Cove Tobago Eco-Industrial and Business Park.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Cutting grass, weeds, trees, and other vegetation using the appropriate tools.
2. Removing grass and other vegetative cuttings to areas identified in the work schedule or by the Supervisor.
3. Clearing concrete or earthen drains of vegetation or other obstacles that can prevent the normal flow of water in these structures.
4. Cleaning the streets and pavements with the assigned tools.
5. Trimming and maintaining plants according to the work schedule or the Supervisor's standard.
6. Cleaning the carparks and other paved areas associated with the buildings identified in the work schedule or by the Supervisor.
7. Hydrating the lawn and plants at the Factory Shells and the Multi Producer Units using the sprinklers associated with these buildings.
8. Assisting with minor construction works, as required.
9. Other related grounds and maintenance activities, as required.
10. Complies fully with the Company's policies and procedures and adheres to the Company's Core Values and Code of Business Conduct by daily demonstration of associated behaviour.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

1. Adherence to the positive culture of E-IDCOT.
2. Excellent customer service.
3. Maintenance of assigned PPE, machinery, and tools.
